Cut out strip Fold over first picture left to right

Cut out covers and fold over to make book cover



Cut the images out in a strip and the cover out.

- Fold first image left to right - then fold back (all images once folders should be on one side of the paper)
- Glue down the plain side of each end to the cover.
- If you wish to make the cover more sturdy cut out thin piece of card the same size as the cover and glue cover to the card.
